Unapproved Select Board Minutes

Chairman Linda Collins called the meeting to order at 7 p.m. Present were: select board members Arthur Pond, Wayne Hurtubise, Norris Tillotson, Sherry Paquette and Collins. Visitors, Eric Collins, Josh Aldrich, Shane Rhodes Nick Pond and Ronnie Sheltra. Hurtubise made a motion to approve the minutes of the August 20 meeting. A second was made by Pond. Motion passed.

Nick Pond wanted to discuss his Eagle Scout Project with the board and will construct something for the town.

Hurtubise reported that the town highway crew is finishing sidewalks and putting up sand for winter. They also installed a storage container at the playground for the fire department.

Paquette reported that she talked to Bob Peters about repair to the library porch.

Pond reported that the security system at the playground is fixed and running and that he got a quote from Larry Patterson for rails on the bleachers. He said Coach Jim Bose has protective rolls for the fence top. He said Road Foreman John Nutting will put in a cement pad for a new trash can, The unit will be made by Patterson and paid by a grant Collins has. He also said five stones will be fixed at the Troy St. Cemetery by Dale Larose. Collins will apply for a grant to fix them.

Eric Collins reminded Paquette that she needs to contact the Dept. of Public Safety to extend the permit for the roof. She was not on the board when the permit was obtained. Hurtubise made a motion to adjourn with a second by Pond.

The board agreed to place an ad in the St. Albans Messenger for a town clerk and extend a Courier ad for another week.

The board reconvened as the Liquor Control Board.

The board unanimously approved a liquor license presented by Ronnie and Cameron Sheltra for the Crossing Restaurant and bar.

The meeting adjourned at 7:50 p.m.
